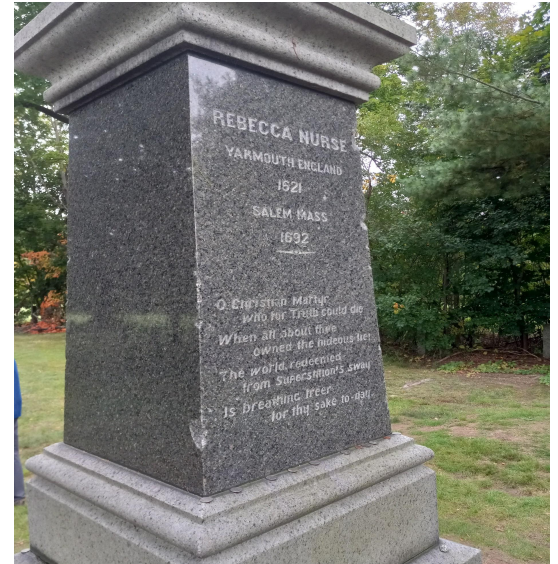


Pictured are the Whitewater group, a view from Mt. Monadnock and Rebecca Nurse's grave near Salem, MA.
